Notice of Eighth Congressional District Democratic Committee

2008 DEMOCRATIC CONVENTION

The Eighth Congressional District Democratic Committee hereby announces that it will hold a District Convention beginning at 10:00 a.m., on Saturday, May 17, 2008, at Francis C. Hammond Middle School, 4646 Seminary Road, Alexandria, Virginia, 22304 for the following purposes: to elect seven delegates and one alternate to the 2008 Democratic National Convention; to nominate members of State Democratic Convention Credentials and Rules Committees; to select a presidential elector representing the Eighth Congressional District in the 2008 general presidential election; to consider resolutions; and, to conduct such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

Persons seeking election as national convention delegates must be identified as to presidential preference. The convention will elect three male delegates (two Obama, one Clinton) and four female delegates (two Obama, two Clinton) and one male alternate (Obama). Each candidate for delegate must file a statement of candidacy indicating that person's candidate preference with the State Party and the Eighth Congressional District Democratic Chair by 5:00 p.m., Friday, May 2 2008. To be eligible for election, delegate candidates and the candidate for alternate must be registered to vote in the Eighth Congressional District.
