



What is the 8th Congressional District Committee?

The 8th Congressional District is composed of **four jurisdictions**: the [City of Alexandria](#), the City of Falls Church, [Arlington County](#), and part of [Fairfax County](#) (including portions of 5 of the 9 Supervisor Districts: [Dranesville](#), [Lee](#), [Mason](#), [Providence](#), and [Mount Vernon](#)).

Membership in the 8th CD includes: The twenty elected members of the Democratic State Central Committee from the Congressional District, duly elected in the following jurisdictions

Alexandria, City of 4 Members (2 female and 2 male)
Arlington 7 Members (3 female and 4 male)
Fairfax 8 Members (4 female and 4 male)
Falls Church 1 Member (1 female)

****Elected members represent their local Democratic committees.**

Who can serve as delegate to the 8th CD?

All Democrats who are registered voters within the district may attend the District Convention and participate as delegates. Delegates elect members within their jurisdiction.

When does the 8th CD Committee reorganize?

Reorganization takes place every 4 years during a gubernatorial election year.

Who can attend meetings?

Participation in the Eighth District Democratic Convention is open to all registered voters who wish to participate as Democrats. All meetings shall be open to all members of the Democratic Party regardless of race, sex, age, color, creed, national origin, religion, ethnic identity, sexual orientation, gender identity, economic status, or disability, and all meetings shall be publicized fully. Voting members are those who were elected at convention. Voting members represent their local Democratic committees.



What is my time commitment?

There are 12 District Committee meetings a year (1 per month) plus 4 quarterly state central committee meetings in Richmond, VA.

Do I need to do any fundraising?

Yes. Each year, members fundraise for the annual Kennedy King Dinner. This includes selling tickets, tables, and, table topper advertising space for the dinner.
